Prayer 1: Prayer for Marriage Restoration

Category: Relationships & Family

Primary Scripture Foundation (KJV): Genesis 2:24; Matthew 19:6; Ephesians 4:2–3, 31–32; Ephesians 5:21–33; Colossians 3:12–14; 1 Corinthians 13:4–7

FULL PRAYER — KINGDOM STRUCTURE

1. RELATIONAL ACCESS — FATHERHOOD

Father, in the name of Jesus, we come before You as Your children.

Before we come to You as husbands or wives, before we speak about what has happened in our marriage, and before we ask You to change our spouse, we acknowledge You as our Father.

We have access to You through Jesus Christ. We come before You knowing that You see what others cannot see. You know every conversation, every disagreement, every disappointment, every wound, every tear, and every moment when distance entered what was once close.

You know where communication broke down. You know where trust was damaged. You know where affection changed. You know what happened publicly, and You know what happened behind closed doors.

Nothing concerning this marriage is hidden from You.

So we do not come pretending. We come as Your children asking our Father for wisdom, mercy, correction, healing, and restoration according to Your will.

2. WORSHIP / HONOR

Father, You are holy.

You are faithful even when people are unfaithful. You are patient even when we become impatient. You are merciful, righteous, just, and true.

You are the God of reconciliation.

You are able to soften hearts that have become hard. You are able to bring truth into places where misunderstanding has lived. You are able to give wisdom where emotions have produced confusion.

We honor You above our feelings.

We honor You above our anger.

We honor You above our disappointment.

We honor You above our desire to prove that we were right.

Marriage does not sit upon the throne. Our spouse does not sit upon the throne. Our pain does not sit upon the throne.

You are King.

And because You are King, we bring this marriage under Your authority.

3. KINGDOM ALIGNMENT

Father, let Your Kingdom come, and let Your will be done in this marriage as it is in heaven.

We do not merely ask You to make this marriage comfortable again. We ask You to bring it into **alignment with Your design**.

Your Word declares:

“What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.”

Where we have allowed pride, selfishness, bitterness, unforgiveness, neglect, dishonesty, resentment, or outside influences to interfere with Your order, expose it.

Do not simply repair what is visible while leaving the foundation broken.

Correct us.

Teach us.

Mature us.

Show each spouse what must change within themselves before pointing toward what must change in the other.

Where our expectations have been governed more by culture than Scripture, realign them.

Where selfishness has replaced service, correct us.

Where competition has replaced partnership, correct us.

Where silence has replaced communication, teach us to speak again.

Where harsh words have replaced gentleness, govern our mouths.

Where familiarity has caused us to stop honoring one another, restore honor.

Let Your Kingdom govern this marriage.

4. PETITION — WITHIN ALIGNMENT

Father, we ask You to restore what can be restored according to Your wisdom and will.

Begin with the heart.

Where love has grown cold, breathe upon it.

Where affection has diminished, restore tenderness.

Where friendship has disappeared, teach this husband and wife how to enjoy one another again.

Where communication has broken down, give them ears to hear before mouths to answer.

Teach them how to disagree without destroying one another.

Teach them how to speak truth without cruelty.

Teach them how to listen without immediately preparing a defense.

Your Word tells us to walk with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Father, produce that kind of character within this marriage.

Where trust has been damaged, give wisdom concerning how it must be rebuilt.

Not merely with promises.

Not merely with apologies.

But with truth, repentance, consistency, accountability, and time.

Where there has been neglect, awaken attentiveness.

Where there has been emotional distance, create opportunities for genuine connection.

Where responsibilities have become unbalanced, bring understanding and cooperation.

Where financial pressure has created conflict, give wisdom and unity.

Where parenting disagreements have created division, give them one heart concerning their children.

Where intimacy has been damaged, bring healing, patience, communication, safety, affection, and restoration according to Your will.

And Father, where outside voices have been given too much authority in this marriage, restore proper boundaries.

Let this husband and wife learn again what it means to become one.

5. FORGIVENESS / ALIGNMENT

Father, now search **us**.

It is easy to remember what our spouse did.

Show us what we did.

Where we have spoken words designed to wound, forgive us.

Where we withdrew affection to punish, forgive us.

Where we stopped listening, forgive us.

Where pride prevented an apology, forgive us.

Where we kept records of wrongs so we could use them in another argument, forgive us.

Where we dishonored our spouse privately or publicly, forgive us.

Where we entertained thoughts, conversations, relationships, or behaviors that violated the covenant, bring genuine repentance.

And Father, give us grace to forgive.

Forgiveness does not call wrong right.

Forgiveness does not eliminate necessary boundaries.

Forgiveness does not mean trust must be restored without repentance and fruit.

But we refuse to allow bitterness to become lord over our hearts.

Your Word tells us to put away bitterness, wrath, anger, clamour, evil speaking, and malice, and to be kind, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven us.

Help us live that truth.

6. PROTECTION / DELIVERANCE

Father, protect this marriage from everything seeking to destroy what You desire to establish.

Protect it from adultery.

Protect it from emotional affairs.

Protect it from secret relationships.

Protect it from pornography and sexual temptation.

Protect it from deception.

Protect it from manipulation.

Protect it from uncontrolled anger.

Protect it from bitterness.

Protect it from destructive outside influence.

Protect it from the lie that another person automatically possesses what this marriage lacks.

Give this husband and wife discernment concerning the enemy's devices.

But Father, keep us from blaming every marital problem on the devil when some things require **repentance, maturity, communication, counseling, accountability, or changed behavior**.

Give us wisdom to know the difference.

And where there is abuse, coercion, violence, or danger, give the person experiencing it wisdom, protection, trustworthy support, and courage to seek safety. Do not allow religious language about restoration to become a reason for someone to remain unprotected in harm.

Let truth govern restoration.

7. DECLARATION

We declare that our marriage belongs under the government of God.

We declare that pride will not govern us.

Bitterness will not govern us.

Anger will not govern us.

Our past will not govern us.

Jesus Christ is Lord.

We declare that we will learn to listen again.

We will learn to honor again.

We will learn to communicate again.

We will learn to serve again.

We will tell the truth.

We will practice forgiveness.

We will pursue peace without sacrificing truth.

We declare that where genuine repentance is needed, we will repent.

Where accountability is needed, we will receive it.

Where wise counsel is needed, we will seek it.

Where patience is needed, we will practice it.

And where restoration is possible according to God's will, we will participate in that restoration rather than merely asking God to do what He has commanded us to do.

8. SEAL — REST & SURRENDER

Father, we place this marriage into Your hands.

We surrender the outcome to You while accepting responsibility for the obedience You require from us.

Give us wisdom for the next conversation.

Grace for the next decision.

Humility for the next apology.

Patience for the rebuilding.

And love that reflects Christ rather than merely emotion.

Teach this husband and wife to see one another again—not simply through the memory of what went wrong, but through truth, grace, wisdom, and Your purpose.

Let Your Kingdom come.

Let Your will be done.

And let this marriage become what You intended it to be.

We trust You with what we cannot repair by ourselves, and we commit ourselves to obeying You in what You have placed within our hands.

Give us grace to forgive without pretending that wrong was right, and wisdom to establish healthy boundaries where they are necessary.

Protect this marriage from temptation, deception, bitterness, destructive influences, and every strategy designed to divide what You desire to restore.

We declare that pride will not govern us. Anger will not govern us. Bitterness will not govern us.

Jesus Christ is Lord over this marriage.
