

Batch 10 — Worship & Adoration

Prayer 5: Pure Adoration — A Prayer That Asks God for Nothing

Category: Worship & Adoration

Primary Scripture Foundation (KJV): Psalm 8:1–9; Psalm 29:1–2; Psalm 63:1–5; Psalm 95:1–7; Psalm 96:1–9; Psalm 103:1–5; Psalm 145:1–13; Isaiah 6:1–5; John 1:1–14; Philippians 2:5–11; Revelation 4:8–11; Revelation 5:9–14

This prayer completes our foundational **Worship & Adoration** collection, and intentionally breaks our normal pattern in one important way:

There is no petition section.

We still retain the theological movement of our Kingdom framework—relationship, honor, alignment, thanksgiving, surrender, declaration, and seal—but today we ask God for **nothing**.

No breakthrough.

No healing request.

No financial request.

No protection request.

No warfare.

No open door.

This prayer exists for one reason:

God is worthy.

FULL PRAYER — KINGDOM STRUCTURE

1. RELATIONAL ACCESS — OUR FATHER

Our Father which art in heaven,

I come before You in the name of Jesus Christ.

And Father, today—

I have brought no list.

You already know my needs.

You already know my concerns.

You already know what I have been praying about.

But for these moments, I intentionally set those things aside.

I did not come because something went wrong.

I did not come because I need You to fix something.

I did not come because I need an answer.

I came because You are my Father.

Through Jesus Christ, I have access to You.

And relationship itself is enough reason to come.

Father, I am here.

Not for Your hand—

for Your heart.

2. WORSHIP / HONOR — HALLOWED BE THY NAME

Hallowed be Thy name.

Holy is Your name.

Your holiness existed before creation.

Your glory existed before humanity.

Your worth existed before worshipers.

Before anyone called You holy—

You were holy.

Before anyone called You good—

You were good.

Before anyone called You faithful—

You were faithful.

Before anyone worshiped—

You were worthy.

Isaiah saw the Lord high and lifted up, and heard the cry:

“Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.”

So I join that confession.

Holy.

Not common.

Not ordinary.

Not created.

Not dependent.

Not changing with culture.

Not adjusting Your character according to human opinion.

You are holy.

3. ADORATION — YOU ARE GOD

Father, I adore You because You are God.

You are eternal.

No one created You.

No one appointed You.

No one elected You.

No one gave You authority.

No one can remove You from Your throne.

You have no predecessor.

You will have no successor.

There was never a moment when You were not God.

And there will never be a moment when You cease to be God.

Generations come and go.

Kingdoms rise and fall.

Cultures change.

Languages change.

Civilizations change.

But You remain.

David declared:

“I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.”

So I bless Your name.

Not because You need affirmation from me.

But because my soul needs to remember **who You are**.

4. ADORATION OF CHRIST — JESUS IS LORD

Jesus Christ, I worship You.

The Word who was with God and was God.

The Word made flesh.

The Lamb of God.

The Son of God.

The Savior.

The Redeemer.

The Good Shepherd.

The Bread of Life.

The Light of the world.

The Resurrection and the Life.

The Way.

The Truth.

The Life.

You humbled Yourself.

You became obedient unto death—
even the death of the cross.

You died.

You were buried.

You rose again.

And Your Word declares:

“Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name.”

Jesus—

You are Lord.

Not merely helper.

Not merely teacher.

Not merely example.

Not merely someone I add to my life.

Lord.

Every knee shall bow.

Every tongue shall confess.

Jesus Christ is Lord.

5. THANKSGIVING — BLESS THE LORD, O MY SOUL

Father, I thank You.

Not because I came asking for anything.

I thank You because I already have reasons.

Thank You for Jesus.

Thank You for salvation.

Thank You for mercy.

Thank You for grace.

Thank You for forgiveness.

Thank You for truth.

Thank You for Scripture.

Thank You for the Holy Spirit.

Thank You for life.

Thank You for breath.

Thank You for every morning I woke up and treated waking up like something ordinary.

Thank You for every meal I ate without thinking about provision.

Thank You for every person who loved me.

Thank You for every lesson that matured me.

Thank You for correction that protected me.

Thank You for mercy I recognized.

And mercy I never knew I needed.

David said:

“Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits.”

So today—

I remember.

6. SURRENDER — MY LIFE BECOMES THE OFFERING

Father, I brought no petition.

But I did bring something.

Me.

My worship cannot merely be words.

So I place my life before You.

My mind.

My hands.

My mouth.

My gifts.

My time.

My resources.

My relationships.

My work.

My private decisions.

My public life.

My future.

I worship You with more than music.

I worship You through obedience.

Through integrity.

Through generosity.

Through forgiveness.

Through service.

Through holiness.

Through loving people.

Through telling the truth when lying would be easier.

Through doing what is right when nobody sees.

Father, let my life say what my mouth says:

You are Lord.

7. DECLARATION — THOU ART WORTHY

Father, I join the worship declared in Revelation:

“Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power...”

You are worthy.

If nothing changes today—

You are worthy.

If no door opens today—

You are worthy.

If no money arrives today—

You are worthy.

If no problem disappears today—

You are worthy.

If I receive no emotional sensation during this prayer—

You are worthy.

Your worth is not determined by my experience.

I declare:

The Father is worthy.

The Son is worthy.

Jesus Christ is Lord.

The Lamb who was slain is worthy.

My worship belongs to God.

My allegiance belongs to God.

My life belongs to God.

8. SEAL — NO REQUEST, JUST WORSHIP

Father, normally this is where I might say:

“Now Lord, I need...”

But not today.

Today I leave the list untouched.

You already know it.

Instead—

I remain here.

Thank You.

[Pause.]

I love You.

[Pause.]

I honor You.

[Pause.]

I worship You.

[Long pause.]

Father, teach me to have more moments like this.

Moments when prayer is not driven by crisis.

Moments when I do not need something to go wrong before I seek You.

Moments when worship does not have an agenda.

Moments when I remember:

God Himself is the treasure.

Your hand is wonderful.

But I want Your heart.

Your provision is wonderful.

But I want the Provider.

Your healing is wonderful.

But I want the Healer.

Your blessings are wonderful.

But I refuse to love Your gifts more than the Giver.

If every gift points me back to You—

then let my attention remain on You.

Father, I came asking for nothing.

And I leave asking for nothing.

I simply declare:

You are holy.

You are good.

You are faithful.

You are worthy.

Jesus Christ is Lord.

And Yours is the Kingdom,

and the power,

and the glory,

for ever.

In Jesus' name,

Amen.

QUICK PRAYER — PURE ADORATION

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I come before You.

And today—

I am asking for nothing.

You already know my needs.

You know my concerns.

But for these moments, I set the list aside.

I came because **You are worthy.**

Hallowed be Thy name.

You are holy.

Good.

Faithful.

Merciful.

Righteous.

Wise.

Eternal.

Before anyone worshiped You, You were worthy.

Before anyone called You holy, You were holy.

Jesus Christ, I worship You.

The Word made flesh.

The Lamb of God.

My Savior.

My Redeemer.

My Lord.

You died.

You were buried.

You rose again.

And Jesus Christ is Lord.

Father, thank You.

Thank You for salvation.

Thank You for mercy.

Thank You for forgiveness.

Thank You for Scripture.

Thank You for the Holy Spirit.

Thank You for life.

Thank You for blessings I have stopped noticing.

Today I remember.

And Father, although I brought no petition—

I bring **myself**.

Let my obedience become worship.

Let my integrity become worship.

Let my service become worship.

Let my life agree with my mouth when I say:

You are Lord.

If nothing changes today—

You are worthy.

If no door opens—

You are worthy.

If I feel nothing—

You are still worthy.

Father, I came asking for nothing.

And I leave asking for nothing.

I simply say:

You are holy.

You are good.

You are faithful.

You are worthy.

Jesus Christ is Lord.

Yours is the Kingdom,

the power,

and the glory,

for ever.

In Jesus' name,

Amen.
